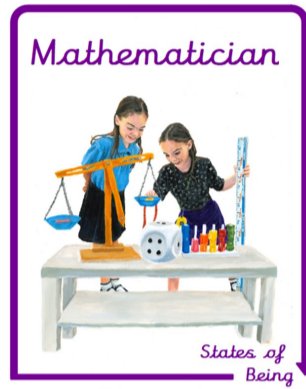


Term 5 in Year 4

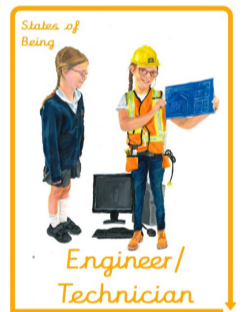
English

In English this term, we will be using a fantastic book called 'Magic Mash' by Peter Firmin to inspire our own food-related fiction! We will brush up on our use of previously looked at skills such as speech punctuation and using commas to mark our fronted adverbials and subordinate clauses as well as apostrophes. After this, we will be using the story to inspire some non-fiction writing!



Enquiry

Our big question this term is 'Why are the food choices we make important?' In this Enquiry, we will learn about the functions of teeth, the digestive system and food chains. We will map where our food comes from, learning about seasonality and where a variety of ingredients are grown, caught, reared and processed. We will start by preparing and cooking a savoury meal but by the end we will be designing an advert for our own seasonal, healthy meal. For this, we will need to be scientists and engineers.



PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be learning about relationships—talking about the people that we have a relationship with but also about serious topics such as love and loss as well as the loss of a pet.

RE

Our big question in RE this term is 'What do Christians learn from the Creation story?' talking about what jobs God gave Christians and how Christians can use the bible as a guide in respect to the creation story.

Spanish

In Spanish this term we will learn to talk about pets and animals! This will include farm animals, jungle animals and we will also have the chance to design and describe a mystery animal!
