Term 4 in Year 4

Maths

In term 4, we will be turning our attention to fractions. We will learn about proper and improper fractions,

mixed numbers and how to add and subtract fractions. This will build on our knowledge of fractions from year 3.



English

In English this term, our key text is Sword of the Viking King which links to our new enquiry. It is about King Alfred and will give us wonderful opportunities to write character descriptions and exciting plots. We will turn our

attention this term to how we can develop a character, using a range of nouns and pronouns and show the reader how a characters feels rather than simply telling them.



Enquiry

Our big question this term is 'Who stood here before us?' It is a fantastic En-

quiry about invaders and settlers: the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings! We will learn who each were and why they invaded Britain,

then turn to the conflict between them and how it was resolved. From there we will become artists, looking at the work of Julie Woodrow to inspire our own clay head models as our final challenge to portray theses two groups of people.





PSHE

Our PSHE unit this term is called 'Healthy Me'. We will explore the way people behave in friendship groups and also that it is okay to have different groups of friends and that these can change.

Spanish

In Spanish this term we will be focusing on the themes of sports and healthy eating as well as some Easter traditions.

Music

This term in music Year 4 will be preparing for our play, 'Porridge', practicing all those songs for our end of term performance!



Computing

In computing this term, we are finishing off our data logging and then moving onto photo editing!
