Historian

As historians, we will be delving into the world of Ancient Briton and identifying how they were engineers. A big part of this will come from our trip to Stonehenge. We will then be looking at Victorians, in particular the industrial revolution, to identify their engineering prowess. This will result in us comparing the two eras and deciding who we think were the greatest engineers.



Computer Engineer

As a computer engineer, we will be exploring webpage creation. Taking into consideration: copyright, aesthetics, and navigation.

As an author, we will be inspired by Wallace and Gromit to write explanation texts and adventure stories.



Linguist

As linguists, we will be developing our vocabulary of the world and learning about celebrations such as day of the dead.

Year 6

Engineer

As engineers, we will be exploring bridges and how they are constructed to serve a purpose and to remain strong. We will revisit learning on pulleys, cogs and levers; looking at how we could incorporate this into our own bridges, that we will design and construct. The construction phase will develop our woodworking skills.



Mathematician
