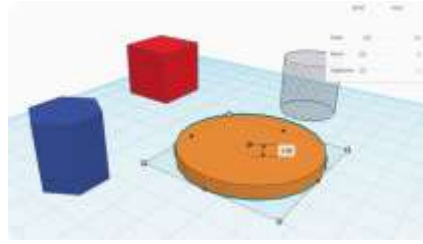
Historian
